Motions/Actions

- 1. Is our wind turbine ordinance still satisfactory considering the changes in state mandates?
- 2. Can we implement a moratorium to stall any parties interested in constructing wind, solar or batteries facilities?
- 3. Are solar farms automatically connected to battery plants or can they be treated separately?
- 4. Is it advisable for us to include greater setbacks than the Hart ordinance?
- 5. What are differences from Hart's ordinance that Weare should consider implementing?
- 6. Can we limit storage facilities by only allowing them in one zone?
- 7. How do we address the lack of salvageability in the decommission plan?
- 8. How can we avoid the potential of developers effectively erasing setbacks by creating borders around contiguous parcels?
