1. ROADS

2. ZONING

Mr. Stevenson stated that the planning commission held a hearing for Mr. McGuire in regards to the trading post property. The Planning Commission approved an outdoor fruit market & car lot upon approval of the Zoning Board of Appeals approving the lot size due to wanting to do retail inside. Once a date is set by the Zoning Board of Appeals letters will be sent out and an put in the paper.

Dale stated that Hart Township is working on zoning for solar panel farms.
